i)	All the Clarifications Provided by Project Proponent Vide their letter No. EStL / ENV/ P3 / 11-07, dated 19/11/2007 should be strictly Complied with.	Noted and Complied. Clarifications mentioned in the letter submitted vide No. EStL/ENV/P3/11-07 dated 19/11/2007 were taken into consideration and strictly followed.
ii)	It should be ensured that no mangroves are destroyed during reclamation. The mangroves present abutting the site should be protected.	Noted and being Complied. In order to protect the existing mangrove area / patches, out of 350 ha (for which EC has been granted) only 186 ha is being reclaimed leaving the remaining mangrove area undisturbed. Moreover, steps has been taken ensure natural tidal flushing of the area like: Regular physical inspections of the area to check any sedimentation, Care has being taken so that the drained water during dreding not get released in the creek feeding the mangroves, Regular checks on the DO levels, Also, construction of trestle berth in a way so that ample amount of tidal flushing will be received by the mangrove areas. M/s. Gujarat Institue of Desert Ecology (GUIDE) has been engaged in Mangrove Mapping of the area and as per their report of October 2017. Please refer Annexure 1 for the report. In addition to these, trestle berth is proposed to connect the reclaimed area on either side of the mangrove area ensuring the natural tidal flushing.
iii)	The Proposed extension to the project should not cause any shoreline changes abutting the project area and the mangrove.	Noted. The National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM) and Institute of Ocean Management has prepared maps of Shoreline change due Erosion/ Accretion at surat, Gujarat coast as per sheet 50, Index no. 78, 79, 80, 81 states that mouth zone of the Tapi estuary where the EBTL's port facilities are set up are classified as "Stable Coast". In addition to this, project was carried out under the recommendations / suggestions made by NIO. Thus changes in shoreline are not envisaged during the project. Please refre Point No. (ii), just above for mangrove area.
iv)	Adequate Provision for beach nourishment and sand bypass should be provided.	Not applicable.

Reclamation in 186 Ha is completed in accordance to the rules and regulation notifed in CRZ Notification 1991 and its amendments. Construction drawings have been approved by GMB before construction.
ii)	Adequate Provisions for infrastructure facilities such as Water supply, fuel, sanitation etc. should be ensured for construction workers during the construction phase of the project so as to avoid felling of trees / mangroves and pollution of water and the surroundings.	Complied.

Being Complied. There is not trade effluent generation thus, setting of wastewater treatment plant is not envisaged. Solid waste generated during the operations is being first segregated and then disposed as per the Soild Waste Management Rules 2016. Regular monitoring for environmental parameters is being carried out in the area. Please find the Annexure 2 for the environment monitoring reports for the period of April 2017 to September 2017.
iv)	The proponent shall obtain the requisite Consents for discharge of effluents and emissions under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act,1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 from the Gujarat Pollution Control Board before Commissioning of the project and a copy of each of these shall be sent to this Ministry.	Complied. Consolidated Consent and Authorization (CCA) has been taken from the Gujarat Pollution Control Board (GPCB) vide Order No. 40300 dated 19/01/2011 which was valid till 22.08.2015. Subsequently we have obtained CCA with Order No. 73836 issued dated 20.10.2015 with an extended validity till 29.07.2020. We have also received CCA as amended to CCA Order No. 73836 for Proposed Expansion vide Order No. AWH-76307 dated 28.03.2016 with a validity till 29.07.2020. Please refer Annexure 3.A to 3.C for the copies of CCAs.
v)	The proponents shall provide for a regular monitoring mechanism so as to ensure that the treated effluents conform to the prescribed standards. The records of analysis reports must be properly maintained and made available for inspection to the concerned State / Central Officials during their visits.	Not applicable . There is no trade effluent generation from this project.
vi)	In order to carry out the environmental monitoring during the operational phase of the project, the project authorities should provide an environmental laboratory well equipped with standard equipment and facilities and qualified manpower to carry out the testing of various environmental parameters.	Noted and Complied. EBTL has its own Environment Management Cell headed by Joint General Manager overlooked by Chief Executive Officer. Monitoring of environmental parameters is being carried out on regular basis and for analysis we have a well-developed and well-equipped laboratory at Essar Steel Plant with qualified manpower.
vii)	The sand dunes and mangroves, if any, on the site should not be disturbed in any way.	Extreme care has been taken during construction as well as during the operational phase so that none of the activity will disturb the mangroves or sand dunes in the area, if present. However, no sand dunes reported in the area.
